- 1609 Sea Venture Sails 2 Jun., leaves Plymouth, Eng.(prob.)
- 1609 Storm 24 July, Monday (prob.)
- 1609 Bermuda ship wreck/landing 28 July, Friday (prob.)
- 1610 Mutiny 24 Jan. (prob.)
- 1610 On Deliverance or Patience, sails to Jamestown, 10 May (prob.)
- 1613 Mary (?) Hopkins buried Hursley, Hampshire, Eng. 9 May (prob.)
- 1613-17 ca. Return to England (prob.)
- 1617 Settles in a home just outside East wall of London (prob.)
- 1617/18 m. Elizabeth (Fisher?) 9 Feb., St. Mary Matfellow, Whitechapel, London (prob.)
- 1618 ca. b. dau. Damaris, England
- 1620 Mayflower sails to America from Plymouth, Eng., 6 Sep.
- 1620 b. son Oceanus, onboard Mayflower
- 1620 Signs Mayflower Compact Provincetown, Cape Cod, 11 Nov.
- 1620 One of 10 Pilgrims to engage in first encounter with American Natives, Cape Cod, 6 Dec.
- 1620 Mayflower arrives in Plymouth Harbor, 16 Dec.
- 1620 Began building common house, 29 Dec.
- 1621 Sent with Myles Standish to meet American Natives, 17 Jan.
- 1621 Samoset spends the night with the Hopkins family, Mar.
- 1621 Hopkins, Winslow and Squanto visit Massasoit, 12 Jul.
- 1623 b. son Caleb, Plymouth
- 1626 b. dau. Deborah, Plymouth
- 1628 b. dau. Damaris, Plymouth
- 1630 b. dau. Ruth, Plymouth
- 1632 b. Elizabeth, Plymouth
- 1644 Will is made 6 Jun.
- 1644 inventory of his estate was taken 17 Jul.
